## Open call for the project

### “Learning lessons from a violent past for the peaceful future”

**History museum of Bosnia and Herzegovina** and **forumZFD** (Forum Civil Peace Service) are pleased to announce the open call for history teachers, multipliers, students and other field experts to join a trilateral project (France- Germany- Bosnia and Herzegovina) made in cooperation with **Buchenwald Memorial** from Germany and **Foundation of Les Milles Camp – Memory and Education** from France. With this project organizers are aiming for the participants to learn more about the past, to learn about educational concepts and methods while teaching about past, and to learn about the individual role and responsibility of each of them in improving above mentioned. The project is financed by the Franco-German Youth Office (FGYO), in the framework of its South Eastern Europe Initiative, and is part of Memory Lab - Trans-European Exchange Platform on History and Remembrance.

Project will be held in **three different phases from October 2018 – December 2019** which implies that participants who are interested in the project and apply for it are **committing** to take part in the whole process and **participate in all three phases** that are planned as it follows:

First phase in Bosnia and Herzegovina – October 2018 (30 September 2018 – 06 October 2018)

Second phase in France – Spring of 2019 (exact dates to be defined)

Third phase in Germany – Autumn of 2019 (exact dates to be defined)

**Working language of the project is English.**

- **Core Issues to be explored**

Multiperspectivity: Different approaches to memory and dealing with the past

Ways of intervening in civil society

Manipulation and instrumentalization of narratives and memories

Different curricula in the school systems

- Requirements for the participants:

Students who are eligible for the project are **students of the last year of Master program** and they should send their **CV, motivational letter and confirmation of their study level (year of study)** to [krizanovic.tijana@muzej.ba](mailto:krizanovic.tijana@muzej.ba) until **15th July 2018**.

\*Students who finished their studies and are currently not professionally involved in educational system are also eligible and can apply for the project.

**Good English language skills are obligatory for all participants.**

**The participation fee for persons from Bosnia and Herzegovina is 20 € per seminar, while other costs will be covered by the Organizers.**

**Participants selected** for the project will be **informed until the end of July 2018** about their selection and further details for the first phase by e-mail address.

Applications send after specified deadline, as well as incomplete applications **will not be taken into consideration**.
